## About the fire alarm protection system

The detector in the apartment and common area will detect both smoke and fire.

**NEVER tamper with the detector in the apartment – under any circumstances!** If tampered with, the owner of the apartment in question may be charged for any costs related to the incident.

**When alarm detector responds to either smoke or heat – the detector will make a noise. During the first 2 minutes, the sound will be hear able only in that apartment – after 2 minuets the alarm will be hearable throughout the building; in all apartments, common areas and the garage. The fire doors in the garage will close and the elevator stops.**

In case of a false alarm – if you are at home – you can find a button in your corridor OR the fire panel in the entrance hall, and reset the alarm. The triggered false alarm will also be reset on the fire panel in the first floor (entrance level).

The procedures have been posted in every corridor – but repeated here:

**(a) Local termination button located in each CORRIDOR**

- (1) If the alarm is accidentally triggered in your apartment, use the button to reset the alarm.
- (2) You will now have 2 minutes to vent the smoke out of your apartment before the alarm spreads to the entire building.
- (3) Each time the button is pushed/reset, you will have another 2 minutes to vent smoke or remove the source of the alarm.
- (4) If a false alarm is spread throughout the whole building, it must be reset at the panel in the entrance hall. Follow the instructions next to the panel (and here):

**(b) Reset the fire panel in the ENTRANCE HALL**

- (1) Press once to reset the sounds of the clock (symbol with clock)
- (2) Press the button once to stop the siren (symbol with the exclamation mark).  
All sounds from the fire alarm will stop.
- (3) Press the button once to reset the alarm to normal mode (symbol on reset).

If the cause of the alarm is resolved, the switch will now return to normal operation.

**NB! Not under any circumstances are you or anybody else allowed to turn off the sound of the fire alarm before you are 100% sure that it is a false alarm – or that the cause of the alarm has been resolved, or the fire has been extinguished.**
